## ISNZ Member School Statistics Report 2011

### School Membership

- 1 ISNZ Member School membership stands at 42. At the end of 2010 Kadimah School, Auckland, ceased operating as a registered private school and in January 2011 opened as a state-integrated school.
- 2 St Michael's Church School, Christchurch, has suspended membership to ISNZ for 2011; therefore its roll number and statistical data is not included in the 2011 statistics data.
- 3 Please note that the 2010 statistics data did **not** include ACG Sunderland and Seven Oaks Education Centre. The statistics analysis for 2011 does include these two schools.

### Student Numbers

In 2011, ISNZ membership in *overall student numbers* has seen a 1.85% decrease.

In 2011, the total number of students enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools is 23,293 (2010 23,731 students).

**Boys' schools** (ie having over 75% boys making up the school roll) represent 28.57% (12 boys' schools) of the total number of ISNZ Member Schools.

**Girls' schools** (ie having over 75% of girls making up the school roll) represent 23.81% (10 girls' schools) of the total number of ISNZ Member Schools.

**Co-educational schools** make up 52.38% (22 co-educational schools) of the total number of schools.

NB: These figures exclude preschool students.

NB: A member school may be included in more than one category, eg boys' school and co-educational school.

The *number of boys* enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools has decreased by 1.30% with boys making up 50.28% of the total number of enrolments.

The *number of girls* enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools has decreased by 2.4% with girls making up 49.72% of the total number of enrolments.

NB: These figures exclude preschool students.

### Boarders

There are 19 ISNZ Member Schools with boarders, three of which have boarders making up the majority of the school roll.

There are a total of 3031 boarders in 2011, a decrease of 1.14% from 2010. Boarders represent 13.01% of the total number of students enrolled at ISNZ Member Schools.

In 2011 there are *2114 boys enrolled as boarders*, a 2.18% decrease from 2010.

In 2011 there are *917 girls enrolled as boarders*, a 1.33% increase from 2010.

Of the 3031 boarders in 2011, 2534 are *secondary school students* (83.6% of total boarders) and 497 are *primary school students* (16.4% of total boarders).

### **Full Boarders/Weekly Boarders**

The raw data from ISNZ Member Schools regarding the number of full boarders and weekly boarders has been difficult to analyse. Some schools have combined full boarding with weekly boarding into one category of full boarding. This applies particularly to those schools that offer weekly boarding options but have one boarding fee that applies to both full boarders and weekly boarders.

Where there is a clear definition between full and weekly boarding numbers, the data is showing a 5.6% increase in the number of weekly boarders and a 1.43% decrease in the number of full boarders.

### **Secondary Schools**

There are 26 ISNZ Member Schools with secondary school students.

Secondary students represent 59% of all students (excluding preschool students) enrolled at ISNZ Member Schools.

There are a total of 13,742 secondary students in 2011 giving a 0.16% decrease from 2010.

### **Primary Students** (including Y7 and Y8 students)

There are 38 ISNZ Member Schools with primary schools (90% of ISNZ Member Schools offer primary education).

There are a total of 9551 primary students giving a 4.27% decrease of primary students enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools.

Primary school students represent 41% of all students (excluding preschool students) enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools.

### **Preschools**

There are 14 schools with a preschool (one more than 2010) (33.33% of ISNZ Member Schools offer preschool education).

There are a total of 658 preschool students enrolled at ISNZ Member Schools, giving a 0.05% decrease from 2010.

Preschool students make up 2.75% of the total number of students enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools.

### **International Students**

There are 32 ISNZ Member Schools with international students.

There are a total of 548 international students (as at 1 March 2011) enrolled at ISNZ Member Schools, giving a 0.9% increase from 2010.

International students make up 2.35% of the total student population (excluding preschool students) in ISNZ Member Schools.

NB: The total number of international students in Christchurch schools may have declined since this data was received.

### **Regional Student Numbers 2006 to 2011**

Please find attached a summary of student numbers in ISNZ Member Schools for the past six years analysed by Year groups and by region.

Auckland:	0.24% decrease in total student numbers
Waikato/Bay of Plenty:	0.26% increase in total student numbers
Central North Island:	11.3% decrease in total student numbers
Wellington:	2.34% decrease in total student numbers
South Island:	4.05% decrease in total student numbers.
Total:	1.85% decrease in total student numbers.

### **NCEA and other School Qualifications**

Of the 26 ISNZ Member Schools that submitted data in this category:

- x 7 schools offer only CIE (Cambridge International Examinations)
- x 7 schools offer only NCEA (National Certificate of Educational Achievement)
- x 5 schools offer NCEA and CIE
- x 7 schools offer NCEA and IB (International Baccalaureate).

### **Student/Staff Ratio** (excluding preschool staff)

The average staff/student ratio for 2011 is 11.47 students per teacher, compared to 12:1 students per teacher in 2010.

### **Grants/GST Analysis**

Please find attached a summary of the GST paid on grants, tuition, boarding fees and additional foreign student tuition fees.

NB: GST for 2011 is shown at the 15% GST  
ISNZ member Schools for 2011 paid collectively \$15,507,608 more in GST than they received in government grants.
