ISNZ Member School Statistics Report 2010

School Membership

- 1 ISNZ Member School membership stands at 43. At the end of 2009 Hill Top School, Auckland, ceased operating as a school and subsequently relinquished its membership to ISNZ.
- 2 In 2010 two new schools have become members of ISNZ. They are:
 - ACG Sunderland School & College, Waitakere City; and
 - Seven Oaks Education Centre, Christchurch.
- 3 The 2010 statistics do not include ACG Sunderland or Seven Oaks.
- 4 In 2010 Corran School merged with Saint Kentigern College and now operates as Saint Kentigern School for Girls-Corran.

Student Numbers

For 2010, ISNZ Member Schools have seen a 2.1% decrease in overall student numbers. In 2009 member schools experienced a 2.58% decrease in overall student numbers.

In 2010, the total number of students enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools is 23,731 (2009 24,234 students).

Boys' schools (ie having over 75% of boys making up the school roll) represent 23.26% (10 boys' schools) of the total number of ISNZ Member Schools; girls' schools (ie having over 75% of girls making up the school roll) represent 23.26% (10 girls' schools) of the total number of ISNZ Member Schools, and coeducational schools make up 53.48% (23 coeducational schools) of the total number of schools. (NB: these figures exclude preschool students.)

The number of boys enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools has decreased by 1.23% with boys making up 50% of the total number of enrolments; the number of girls enrolled has shown a decrease of 2.91% with girls representing 50% of the total number of enrolments. (NB: these figures exclude preschool students.)

Boarders

There are 19 ISNZ Member Schools with boarders, four of which have boarders making up the majority of the school roll. Boarders make up 12.92% of the total number of students enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools.

There are a total of 3066 boarders in 2010, a decrease of 1.32% from 2009.

Of this number, 2161 are boys, showing a 1.19% decrease from 2009, and 905 are girls, showing a 1.63% decrease from 2009.

Of the 3066 boarders, 2542 are secondary school students and 524 are primary school students.

There has been a 1.15% decrease in the number of full time boarders for 2010 and a 2.84% decrease in the number of weekly boarders.

Secondary Schools

There are 25 ISNZ Member Schools with secondary students, compared to 26 in 2009.

Secondary students represent 58% of all students (excluding preschool students) enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools.

Primary Students (including Y7 and Y8 students)

There are 38 ISNZ Member Schools with primary schools (one less than 2009).

There are a total of 9967 primary students, giving a decrease of 3.33% of primary school students enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools.

Primary students represent 42% of all students (excluding preschool students) enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools.

Preschools

There are 13 schools with a preschool (one more than 2009).

There are a total of 661 preschool students enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools (same number as 2009).

Preschool students represent 2.71% of all students enrolled in ISNZ Member Schools.

International Students

There are 33 ISNZ Member Schools with international students.

There are a total of 543 international students in member schools this year, giving a decrease of 4.74% from 2009.

International students make up 2.29% (excluding preschool students) of the total number of students enrolled at ISNZ Member Schools.

Selected Year Group Trends

Year 9: In 2007, ISNZ Member Schools saw an increase of 10% of student numbers in Year 9. There has been a significant decrease in Year 9 numbers since then:

2008	6.5% decrease
2009	6.85% decrease
2010	4.08% decrease.

Year 11: In 2007, ISNZ Member Schools saw an increase of 11% of student numbers in Year 11.

2008	9.45% decrease
2009	3.64% decrease
2010	1.54% increase.

Year 13: In 2007, ISNZ Member Schools saw an increase of 12.58% of student numbers in Year 13.

2008	2.61% decrease
2009	0.12% increase
2010	1.02% increase.

Regional Student Numbers 2006 to 2010

Please find attached a summary of student numbers for the past five years analysed by Year groups and by region.

This information has not been available in previous years, but I believe it is worthy of inclusion in the statistical analysis and worthwhile information for member schools looking at regional trends.

Secondary School Qualifications

Of the 25 ISNZ Member Schools offering secondary school qualifications:

- x 3 schools offer only CIE (Cambridge International Examinations)
- x 5 schools offer only NCEA
- x 7 schools offer NCEA and CIE
- x 10 schools offer NCEA and IB (International Baccalaureate)
- x 2 schools offer NCEA, IB and CIE.

Student/Teacher Ratio

The average student/teacher ratio for 2010 is 12:1 students per teacher. Please note six schools did not provide data so the sample group was reduced.

In 2009, the average student/teacher ratio was 13:1.

Grants/GST Tuition and Boarding Fees Analysis

Please find attached a summary of the GST paid on grants, tuition, boarding and foreign student tuition fees.

You will note that ISNZ Member Schools for 2010 paid collectively \$7,032,058 more in GST than they received in government grants.

NB: these figures are compiled from statistics provided by ISNZ Member Schools. Whilst all possible care is taken with checking any obvious omissions and anomalies, we still cannot assure total accuracy.

New members and changing school structures impact on year to year comparisons.
